Vajrayogini Retreat Session by His Eminence Luding Khen Rinpoche

Sakya Tenphel Ling is organizing a short Vajrayogini retreat session at Bojjhanga Bhavana Centre Bali, for those who have taken commitments on the Vajrayogini practice and is keen to undergo a full retreat on the deity in the near future. His Eminence Luding Khen Rinpoche, who have been guiding us in the Vajrayogini practice for the past 10 years during His 2-yearly Visit to our Centre, will be invited to lead us in the path during the retreat.

Information on the Retreat

The date of the Vajrayogini Retreat is from 20th October to 1 November 2017.

(The prerequisite for the retreat must have. completed.the 7 days Vajrayogini teaching with body mandala and uncommon meditation beyond thought.)

The Place is Bojjhanga Bhavana Centre, Jl. Penelokan -Kedisan Desa Kedisan. Kintamani, Bali.

Registration

Registration starts from **01 July 2017** The last day of Registration will close on **31 July 2017** to allow adequate time for the organizer to prepare participants for the oversea trip.

The number of participants will be limited to the 1st 48 registrants (2 rooms are occupied by the translators).

Brief Biography of His Eminence Luding Khen Rinpoche

Luding Khen Rinpoche, Jamyang Chokyi Gyaltzen was enthroned on 16 March 2000 as the abbot of the Ngor Monastery of the Sakya Order in Manduwala, India, and head of hundreds of other branch monasteries. He comes from a very pure and holy lineage of the Sakyapa Tradition. His mother is Her Eminence Jetsun Kushog Chime Luding, who is the elder sister of the present 41st Throne Holder of the Sakya Tradition, His Holiness The Sakya Trizin. His

fraternal uncle is His Eminence Kyabje Dorje Chang Luding Khenchen Rinpoche, the 75th throne holder of the Ngor sub-sect of the Sakya tradition. Therefore he is one of the most important young lineage holders of the Sakya Order who is in the pure lineage of the Luding Labrang.

Luding Khen Rinpoche was chosen at a very young age to be the future Lineage holder of Ngor and has spent the past three decades in intensive study and meditation since the age of five. He excelled in the rigorous course of Buddhist training. In addition to mastering years of esoteric teachings at the famous Ngor School of Ritual Studies and advanced philosophical training at the Sakya College, Luding Khen Rinpoche has received many Sakya oral instructions passed from great lineage holders to their successors. Following this, he spent years in meditation retreat on the practices of all of the major tantric deities. After his enthronement, His Eminence looks after the Ngor Monastery and gives teachings to the monks including the precious Lam Dre Teaching.

Requested by His Holiness Sakya Trizin and His Eminence Luding Khenchen Rinpoche (senior), Luding Khen Rinpoche is now giving teachings to the public. He is travelling regularly in alternate year giving teaching, bestowing empowerments and performing rituals in many Sakya Centres in the Asia Region like Taiwan, Singapore and Malaysia, and also other foreign Sakya Centre of the world such as Australia and Europe. His Eminence has been visiting our Centre every 2 yearly bestowing the the Teaching and Chin Lab on Vajrayogini and Wang Chen on Cakrasamvara for the last 10 years. In recent years He had visited Tibet twice, the most recent being last year and bestowed numerous Teachings and empowerments to the Tibetans, reviving and bringing together many Sakya monasteries thus spreading the Buddha dharma far and wide.

Possessing a very humble and friendly nature, Rinpoche is liked by many and have disciples all over the world. This time round, Rinpoche has advanced His Teaching on Vajrayogini to all the qualified practitioners of STL, and is leading us to the Path directly with Retreat Sessions so as to encourage us to enter into full retreat to meet our commitment to the practice. As this is a rare and auspicious occasion where His Eminence gives His personal attention, we encourage all those who are qualified, to attend this retreat session.
